Leadership Sheridan County is a unique educational program designed to broaden the base of quality leadership by inspiring citizens to assume leadership roles while extending their awareness of community affairs/resources and strengthening their individual leadership skills.

#### PROGRAM GOALS

# *Inspire and Cultivate Future Leaders*

Strengthen individual leadership skills to benefit local businesses and organizations through development opportunities in order to expand the base of quality leadership in our community.

## Expand Community Knowledge

Increase the awareness and gain a deeper understanding of the Sheridan County community and its wide range of resources as well as encourage active involvement in civic and community affairs.

## Establish Valuable Connections

Connect with community and business leaders as well as develop and strengthen relationships to benefit the professional careers and civic activities of program participants.

#### **PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY**

Anyone, age 18 or over, may apply to participate in Leadership Sheridan County. Area businesses, public and private agencies, civic groups and other organizations are asked to sponsor individuals with leadership potential for participation in the program. Participants should possess a desire to learn about the history and the future of Sheridan County, both from an economic and a cultural perspective.

Program participants must have the support and commitment of their employer. This helps to ensure the participant is able to fulfill the program requirements.

### PROGRAM COMMITMENT

#### YEAR ONE

The program begins with a full day orientation retreat, followed by an overnight module to the state capitol, as well as seven other full-day modules and a graduation event, all within a ten-month time period. Program participants are expected to attend all modules to be recognized as a Leadership Sheridan County graduate.

#### **YEAR TWO**

In addition to the initial time commitment described above, program participants will assist with coordination of the Leadership Sheridan County program for the following year.

## **TUITION AND APPLICATION**

Tuition for the Leadership Sheridan County program is \$850 and includes all study materials, transportation (when required) and meals. The application deadline for the 2022 program is November 1, 2021. This program has a limited number of openings. Therefore, please thoughtfully craft your answers as they are evaluated when considering your application for admission to the program. Once you have sent in your application, you will receive a confirmation email stating we have received it.

The Leadership Sheridan County Steering Committee will notify applicants in writing by November 19, 2021 if they are selected for the program.
